3 Landowners Apply for Permission to Get Final Court Review

Toronto, Ontario (August 6, 2009, 2009) Tonbridge Power Inc. (TSXV-TBZ) ("the Company") announced today that three landowners along the planned route of the MATL line have filed a request with the Supreme Court of Canada, ("SCC"), requesting permission to appeal the Court of Appeal of Alberta's decision to uphold MATL's Alberta Energy and Utilities Board, (AEUB) Permit. The AEUB permit was granted August 12, 2008. Fourteen Landowners appealed the AEUB's decision to the Court of Appeal of Alberta which ruled against them on May 5, 2009. Three of the original fourteen appellant landowners are now asking the SCC to overturn that Court of Appeal of Alberta's decision. The basis for any review, if granted, would be limited to errors in law in the court of appeal decision, if any, that are of a national interest.

The basis of the arguments in the application is the same as that rejected by the National Energy Board, the Alberta Energy Utilities Board and the Court of Appeal. Accordingly, it is the Company's view upon legal advice that this request is without merit and believes the SCC will decline to hear the appeal. This view is supported by the Company's external counsel who have advised that appeals to the SCC must meet a rigorous National and Public interest test which is not in evidence in this case. The appeal of an Alberta court decision regarding an Alberta regulatory matter is unlikely to meet that test as it cannot have application beyond Alberta. The National Energy Board permit was not appealed by the landowners and is beyond appeal at this point.

The Company will proceed with its financing and construction plans and expects no delays or cost increases as a result of this latest action. The Company's permits and right to design, construct and operate an international power line remains all uninterrupted.

Johan van't Hof, CEO of Tonbridge Power, stated, "Our construction schedule is designed to permit certain tasks to be completed in stages such that the landowners may have their due process and we can continue our project without interfering with either MATL's in-service date or budgeted costs."

The Company is the 100% controlling shareholder of Montana Alberta Tie Ltd. ("MATL"), which is developing a 300 MW, 230kV transmission line to interconnect the electricity markets of Alberta and the US. Tonbridge is listed on the TSX Venture Exchange and trades under the symbol "TBZ".
